It has been a very busy week this week, as we have been preparing our classroom and ourselves for King Charles III's forthcoming coronation.

During Talk4Writing this week, we have been learning how to write a letter. It was the wish of the children to write a letter to the King to congratulate him in his new role. We began the week by finding the address of Buckingham Palace on the internet and addressing our envelopes. We learnt about the letter greetings 'To' and 'Dear' and selected to use 'Dear' to start our letter, because King Charles III is a very important person. Next, we explained why we were writing the letter and included the qualities we thought were needed to be a good King. Finally, we shared how we will be celebrating the coronation and ended our letter with 'Yours sincerely.'

The coronation theme spilled over into Maths this week also. We revisited our previous learning about 3D shapes by recapping their names and added to this information by learning about 3D shape properties. We transferred and linked this knowledge by looking at the coronation route King Charles III will be taking and identified the buildings enroute. We used wooden bricks to build these structures and practised naming the 3D shapes we had used, as well as looking closely at photographs of these landmarks to identify the properties of the building themselves.

We have worked hard throughout the week on preparing our learning areas both indoors and outdoors, so that they are 'coronation ready.' We have been exercising our imagination by using everyday school-based items to develop our learning areas. We have been hosting royal dinner parties indoors at our newly laid dining table, complete with champagne glasses and a range of tasty treats. We have also established a 'beautification area', where we can dress in our finest attire and adorn ourselves in the finest jewels ready for a feast with royalty! Outdoors, we have fashioned a golden coronation carriage using fabrics, complete with lacrosse stick horses, skipping rope reins and chairs for the footmen.

We look forward to expanding and developing these areas next week.
