Dear Parents,

First of all I should like to thank you for all the kind words, Christmas cards and gifts I received at the end of last term. They were very much appreciated. The children have returned to school - rested and having enjoyed a good holiday, and I am pleased to say they have readily settled back into school routines.

School Achievement

We were extremely pleased with the attainment levels our pupils achieved last year. However, it was not until the national data was published in the infamous 'League Tables' mid-December that we realised just how exceptionally well our Y6 pupils had done. With an APS (average point score) of 33.1, we were once again top in Buckinghamshire - a position we have held several times before - and joint 35th in the country!

Staff Changes

At the end of last term, Mrs Fossel left to take on a similar position at Godstowe Preparatory School, and Mrs Kingman also moved on. I am sure you will join me in wishing them all the best for the future. We are in the process of recruiting new support staff to replace them.

Clubs

School clubs have all resumed this week. The new KS2 Creative Dance Club will go ahead on Wednesdays, starting next week on 13th January. Assessment Meeting 2nd February

On Tuesday 2nd February at 7.30 p.m., we will be holding our annual Assessment Meeting. This will be of relevance to all parents. Teachers will explain what is involved in the e-profile, the Y1 Phonics Test, the changes to the national Key Stage 1 and 2 standard assessment tests (SATs), and how you can help and support your child at each stage. We will also explain how the new system of 'assessment without levels' works, following the introduction of the revised national curriculum. Details of the new age-related expectations for each national curriculum year will be made available during the evening.

As part of the successful Global Village Project held last term, we raised £85. The children will now be consulted as to what to spend this money on; we will donate to organisations such as Oxfam and Christian Aid who organise 'living gifts'. Thank you to all who contributed.
